Council Vice President Laura Toy offered a denying resolution.

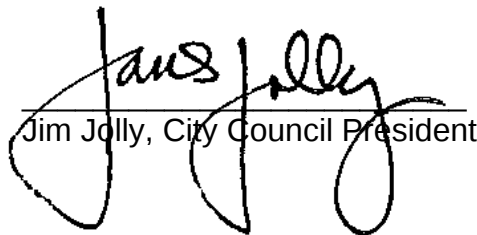
