- Introduction of conceptual master plan
- The Administration and vendors are looking for cost savings and value engineering while maintaining integrity of new city buildings.
- There was talk about the future of the Civic Center Library and why or why not to invest into an aging outdated library.
- The administration is discussing potential ballot language to present to the City Council to fund the building of a Police Department, potential library, renovation to the fire stations, central gathering area, and underground infrastructure.
- The language needs to be sent to Council first, if Council approves the language, it is sent to the State and then County to be voted on by residents in August of 2025.
- Significant work is still needed. The administration is actively working on bringing all info to the Council and community.
- Renderings are only conceptual and will continue to evolve and grow with time.
- All meetings are open to the public and encourage the community to participate.

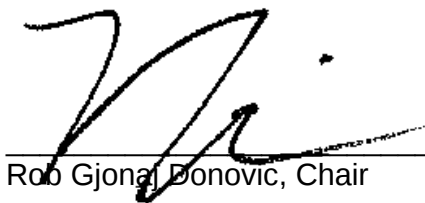
The meeting adjourned at 9:34 PM.
